

Dr. Kosin Chamnongthai is a Professor at King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi (KMUTT), Bangkok, Thailand. He received a B.Eng. in Applied Electronics from the University of Electro-Communications in 1985, an M.Eng. in Electrical Engineering from Nippon Institute of Technology in 1987, and a Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering from Keio University in 1991.

Then, he joined the King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi (from 1991 until now), served as head of the Electronic & Telecommunication Engineering Department, KMUTT (1999-2002), and dean of Engineering Faculty at the University of Thai Chamber of Commerce (2002-2004). He was promoted to professor of KMUTT in 2013.

Dr. Kosin is a senior member of IEEE, and a member of APSIPA, ECTI, AIAT, TRS, TESA, and EEAAT. His research interests are included in the areas of computer vision, image processing, signal processing, and pattern recognition. In these areas, he has published over 60 refereed international journal papers, over 200 international conference papers, and three books. He holds three patents related to fruit inspection.

He was a founding member of the ECTI Association and served as editor of ECTI E-Magazine (2011-2015), associate editor of ECTI-CIT (2011-2016), and ECTI-EEC (2003-2010). He has worked as a committee (2002-2015), vice president (2016-2017), and president (2018-2019) of the ECTI Association.
